

In 2016/17 nonelective admissions were 4.6% below plan for the year

Significant improvement was made throughout 2016/17 on Delayed transfer of care In 2016/17, 92.8% of people remained at home 91 days post discharge

The rate of admissions into residential care homes reduced significantly in 2016/17 but remained slightly above plan at 698 per 100,000 population The number of people feeling supported with their long term condition has increased from 59.1% in 2014/15 to 60.1% in 2015/16 and we are on track to meet the target set for 2016/17
